Take this booklet with you to help you look. It has been split into four parts because there is a lot to see.

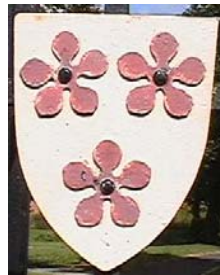

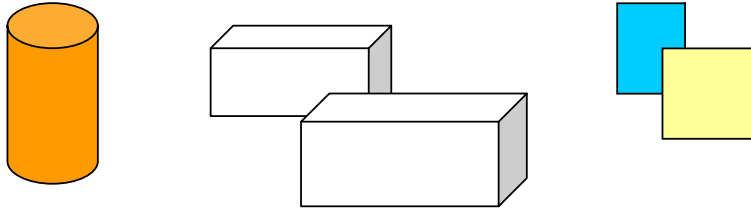

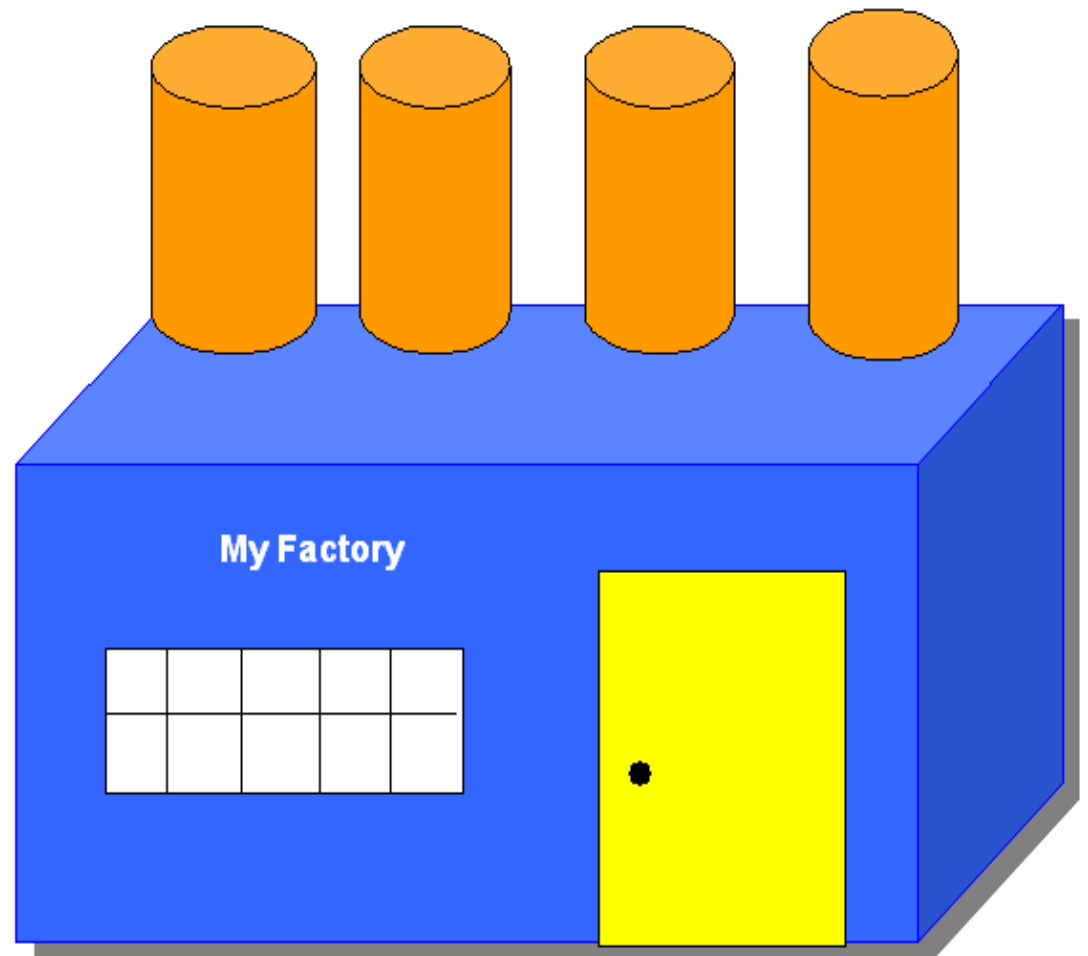
Make your own modern building

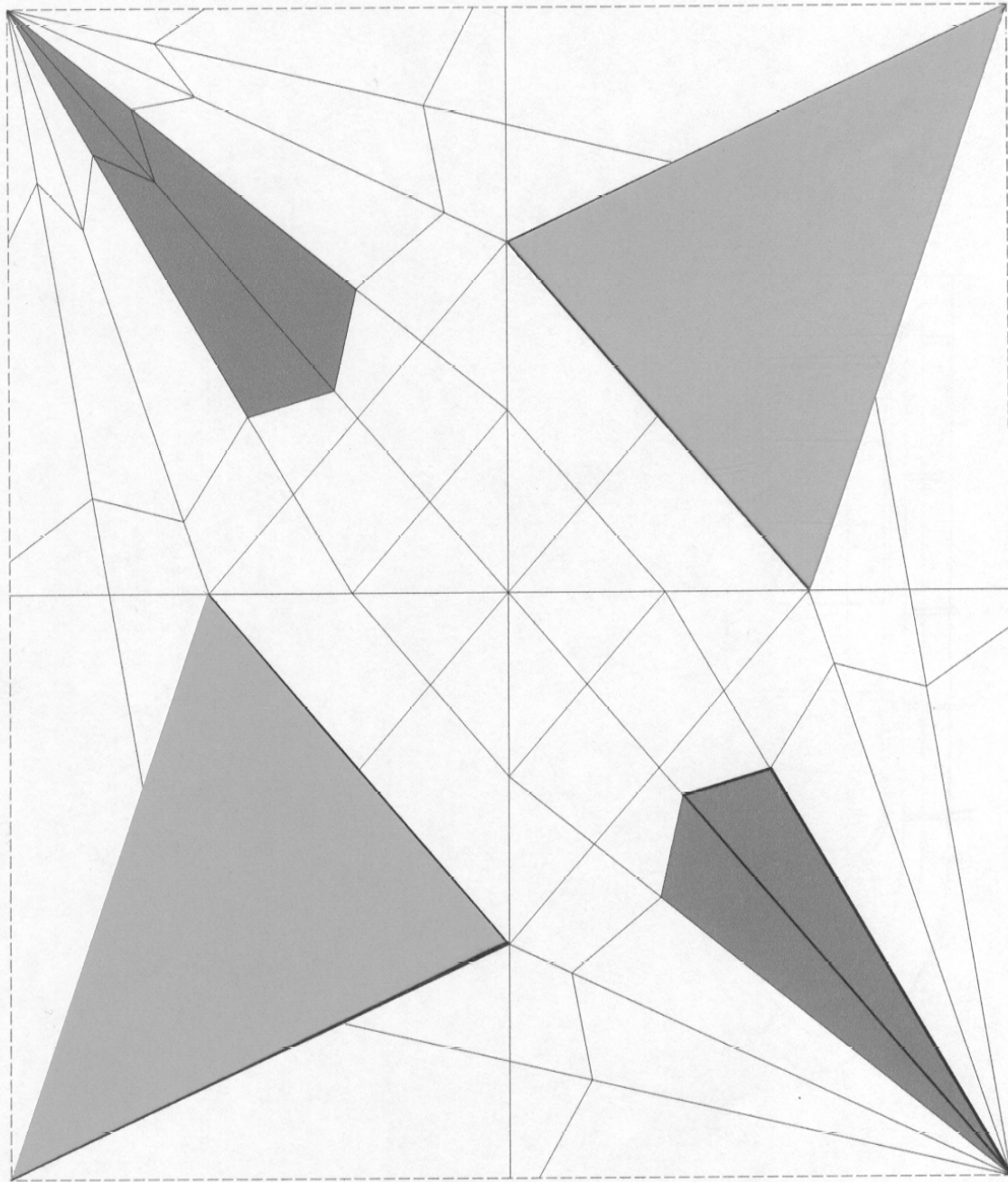
You will need:

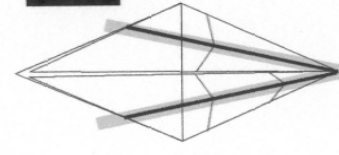
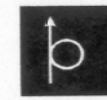
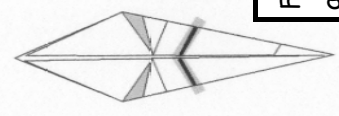
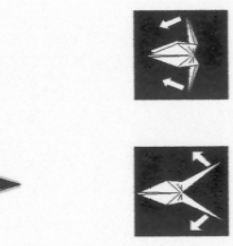
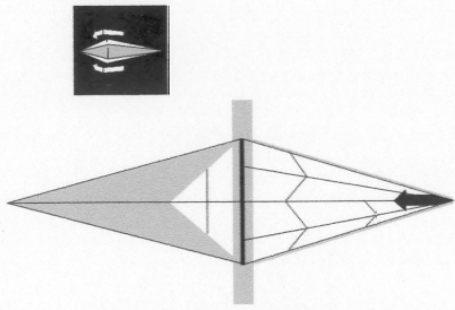
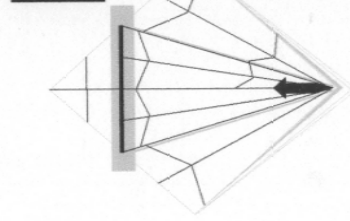
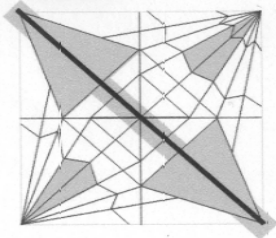
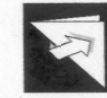
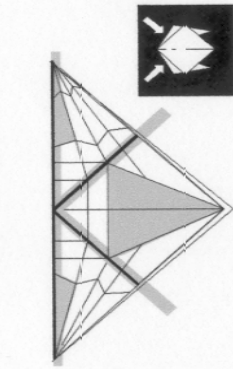
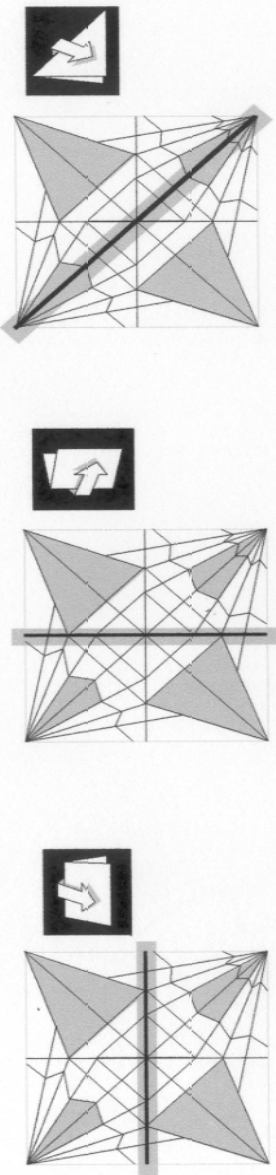


The Heron

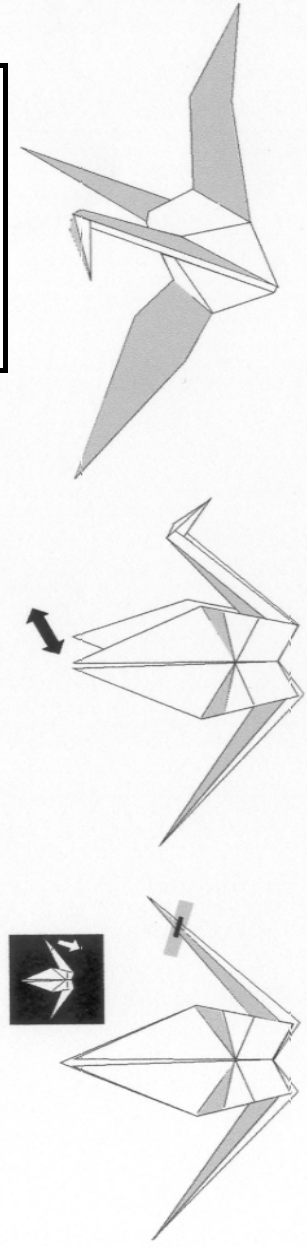
The heron is a beautiful bird, but fishermen hate it because it hunts fish in lakes and rivers with its long, spear-like beak.

How to fold your heron.



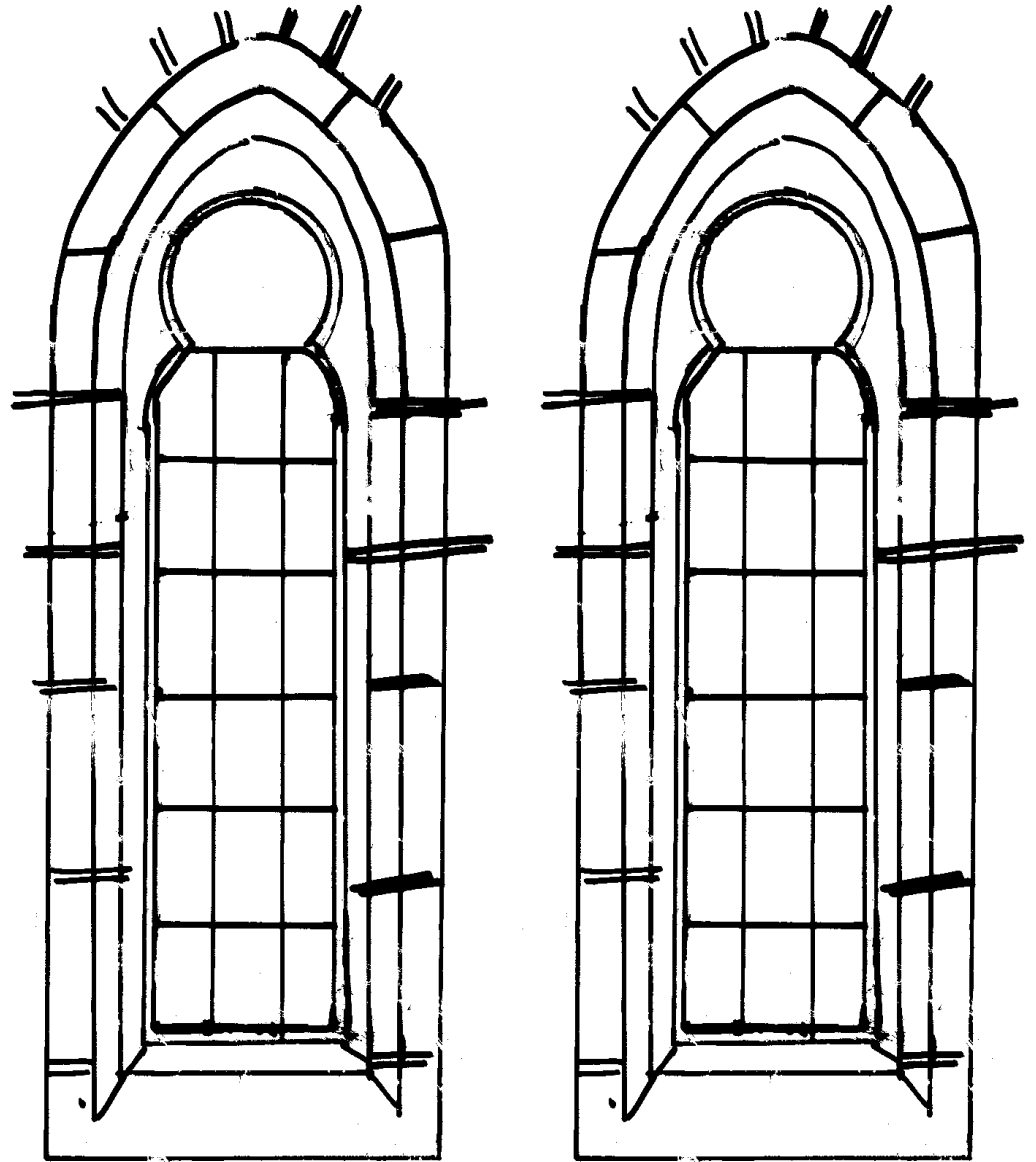
